All Golfers Course Information

- Tee boxes are numbered. Men hit from #5, women from #3.
- For hole #13 and the hole-in-one prize, senior men must hit from Tee #5 to be eligible.
- No gimmies

Stroke Play Golfers

Play your ball only at all times. Record your score on the card and Live App Scoring system. You are entered in to Team USA or Team Japan according to your registration form.

Stroke play golfers only are eligible for the following prizes according to the information recorded on your entry form:

•	Low net – best net score	\$100 Chef Naoko gift certificate
•	Low gross – best gross score	\$100 Sho Restaurant gift certificate
•	Low net, women	\$50 Chef Naoko gift certificate

Scramble

You play as a foursome (or 2 or 3 if short). Each person hits each shot. After each shot is taken, agree on which ball is the "best". Pick up other balls. All hit from the point of the best ball for the next shot. Record your score for each hole.

•	Scramble low score	\$100 Sho Restaurant gift certificate
•	Scramble most birdies	\$50 Sho Restaurant gift certificate

Friendship Cup presented by Sapporo Premium Beer, Team Japan vs. Team USA – Lowest average gross score of all players combined. Stroke players entered individually. Scramble team counted as 1 player. Lowest 3 scores of both teams are eliminated from consideration.

Mulligans - \$15 for 1 or 4 for \$40.

String – \$20 - receive 6' of string and a pair of scissors. Cut the string your desired length, measure from ball towards hole and move ball. Can be used to "hole out" if you wish. Use string until all 6' used once only.

Honor System used for both mulligans and string use.
