Indoor Spaces

You must wear a mask indoors

Outdoor Spaces

- You must wear a mask except during golf and eating lunch
- Bag drop off is still available. However, golfers must carry their own bag down to their cart.
- Carts are still in use, with a clear plastic screen divider between players. 2 players per cart.
- If you are uncomfortable sharing a cart with another player, please let Graham know in advance if possible.

Check-In & Breakfast Area

- JASO Volunteers will wear masks for everyone's convenience and comfort.
- Players should wear masks except when eating, if you cannot socially distance from others.
- Breakfast is served outside next to check-in.
- Please use the utensils provided to select your breakfast items.

BBQ Lunch

- Lunch is served in the Red Barn, with the main sides open.
- Players should wear masks except when eating.
- Tables will be set with 6 chairs, rather than 8.
- Buffet lunch will be served as follows:
- Tables will be called to form a line at the buffet. Players should stand 6' apart in line.
- When you reach the front of the line, the server will take a plate and walk down the buffet with you, plating food using utensils as you request. They will hand you the plate at the end of the line, and repeat with the next player.
- Food service will take a little longer than usual, so please be patient with us.
